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Some Key Challenges for Training in RRI

- RRI covers multiple agendas, multiple and (often) ill-defined or uncertain outcomes, and involves several processes
- RRI covers multiple stakeholders, whose interests are not always going to be aligned
- If genuinely implemented – not tick-box – RRI implies deep culture change for many partners and participants
- Both starting point and desired final point may be unclear
- **So what might this look like in “real life”**

What's in a showcase

1. **Introduction:** why this is interesting for RRI and pointers to what we might get from it;
2. **The story:** this is the key part of the showcase, and the more you can bring it to life by interviewing key actors, the better;
3. **Key issues for trainers:** what the showcase can deliver and what it does not cover, in terms of the outcomes, processes, agendas and stakeholder groups; **+ RRI ISSUES – C/W PROJECT BRIEF**
4. **Workshop training exercises:** scenario exercises; tell-the-story and discuss *etc.*
5. **Useful resources:** a model presentation; website locations; a.v. material; original documents
